



# Residential Service: Do you have used motor oil in your home? Old cans of paint? Unwanted electronics?



Waste Management offers a convenient service in your community for residents to properly dispose and recycle your home generated special materials— safely, easily, and responsibly. This service will help you dispose of your unwanted items through this easy to use, year-round home collection service. Your collection will need to be scheduled through Waste Management’s At Your Door Special Collection® service, however you are not required to be present at the time of the collection.

## HOW DOES THIS SERVICE WORK?

- 1** SCHEDULE A COLLECTION  
To participate, residents must contact this service to schedule a pickup of your items. You will be asked several questions including your address and an inventory of the items for collection. You will be assigned a specific date when these items will be picked up at your home.

- 2** PREPARE FOR THE COLLECTION  
A Collection Kit with instructions will be mailed to your home. This kit will include a collection kit bag and instructions. Read the instructions carefully, and follow the list of acceptable and unacceptable items.
- 3** COLLECTION DATE  
By 7:00 a.m. on the day of your collection, place the Collection Bag near your front door or other area on your property in an easy to find location. Don’t place items at the curb. The materials will be picked up at your home.

## ITEMS ACCEPTED THROUGH THIS SERVICE:



### Automotive Products

Antifreeze, batteries, fluids, waxes, motor oil, oil filters, upholstery cleaner, and more



### Mercury containing items

Compact fluorescent lamps, fluorescent tubes, thermometers, and more



### Garden Chemicals

Fertilizers, insect sprays, herbicides, pesticides, and weed killers



### Paint Products

Paint, glue, caulk, spray paint, stripper, stain, thinner, wood preservative and more



### Swimming pool chemicals

Tablets and liquids



### Needles

Syringes, sharps, needles and lancets



### Household Chemicals

Ammonia, bleach, heavy-duty cleansers, shower/tile cleaner, toilet bowl cleaner, drain cleaner, rust remover, and more



### Electronics

Computers, monitors, TVs, DVD/CD players, cell phones, microwaves, tape players, VCRs, desktop printers, fax machines, keyboards, gaming consoles, and more.



### Flammable items

Gasoline and kerosene

All items must be easily identifiable. Liquids must be placed into containers of 5 gallons or less. Check your instruction sheet for details on how to properly package your unwanted items. Materials must be clearly identified and acceptable materials are dependent upon compliance with local, state and federal regulations.
